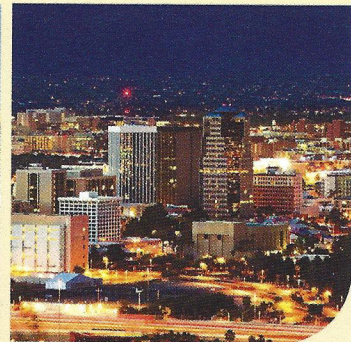
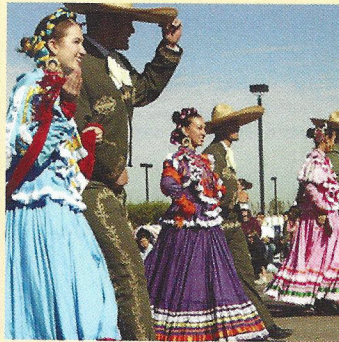
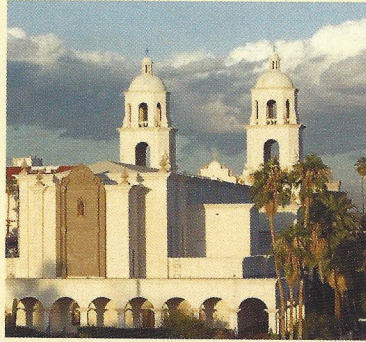
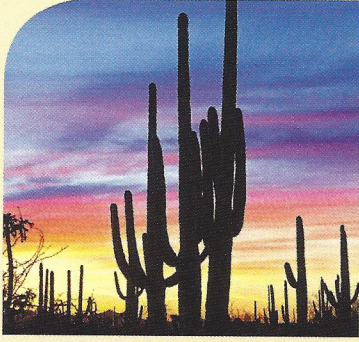


PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, community-wide engagement in programs and activities is needed in order to make our children the best readers in the world;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jonathan Rothschild, Mayor of the City of Tucson, Arizona, do hereby proclaim February 2016 to be

LOVE OF READING MONTH


in our community, and encourage all citizens, young and old, to celebrate and encourage the practice and joy of reading.
